## Outdoor Learning Day: Friday, 26th January 2024

## **Dear Parents and Carers**

On Friday, 26<sup>th</sup> January, all classes will be learning outside with the theme of 'Winter'. The children will participate in a range of outdoor learning activities, throughout the day, linked to areas of the curriculum. At the end of the day, all of the children will be asked to complete a home-learning activity, following the same time-frame as usual. This will be posted onto Tapestry for Year R and onto Teams for Years 1 and 2.

On Friday 26<sup>th</sup> January, Year 2 children will already be in their PE kits as Friday is their usual PE day. However, **Years R and 1 are also invited to wear their winter PE kits on this day too:** Solent PE t-shirt and school jumper/ cardigan with black leggings or jogging bottoms. However, children should come prepared with layers of clothes (such as jumper or fleece) that they can remove/replace as and when needed. The appropriate footwear for the day's activities would be trainers. All children will need a warm, waterproof coat and, depending on the weather that week, they may also need a hat and gloves. Please do check the forecast as the weather seems especially changeable this year!
